DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

*****UPDATE*****

At approximately 1:45pm, a Boyton Beach Police Crime Scene Investigator spotted the suspect's vehicle from a Be On the Look Out (BOLO) that was broadcasted this morning regarding the homicide. The suspect's vehicle then entered onto Interstate 95 southbound at Gateway Boulevard in Boyton Beach. Boyton Beach officers attempted a traffic stop, however the driver/suspect refused to comply. Officers pursued the vehicle southbound until it crashed just south of the Congress Avenue exit in Boca Raton. Boyton Beach police officers ordered the driver out of the vehicle wherein he refused to comply and shot himself in the head. The suspect was transported to Delray Medical Center where he died from his injuries (gunshot).

Furthermore, investigation revealed that the victim's 6 year daughter was at the residence at the time of the shooting.

This is an on-going investigation and no further information will be released at this time.

Sound will be provided at the Pembroke Pines Police Department at 4:30pm today.

At approximately 2:28 this morning, members of the Pembroke Pines Police Department responded to a 911 call regarding a possible shooting at the above listed location. Upon arrival, responding officers found the victim deceased from an apparent gunshot wound to the head. The victim was located in the master bedroom of the apartment.

Investigators have determined through witness accounts that the victim's boyfriend (listed suspect) is the suspect in this homicide.

The suspect was last observed leaving the scene in a 2001 White Nissan Maxima with a possible Florida tag of 671WCI.

The suspect is considered to be armed and dangerous. See attached photograph of Suspect Cerve.

At this time no further information will be released. Sound will be available at the Pembroke Pines Police Department at 10:30 am.
