Pembroke Pines Police learned of a bomb threat, that was received via email overnight, containing a vague threat to Silver Trail Middle School.

As a precautionary measure, School Board officials decided to evacuate the school until the building could be searched by K9 officers. This is an ongoing investigation. We will update you as new information becomes available.
