DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

On Wednesday 5-7-14, the adult sister of the listed victim contacted the Pembroke Pines Police Department to report this suspicious incident.

On Saturday 5-3-14, between noon and 5:00 pm, her younger sister (14 Y.O.A.) was walking along the sidewalk with some other girlfriends who were further ahead of her. An older model tan pick-up truck with an open bed and a darker tan stripe on the side, pulled up to the juvenile and asked if she knew an unknown male that "passed by on a bicycle". The juvenile shook her head in response (no). The W/M subject then asked her "Do you want to get to know me?" as he pointed to the empty passenger seat of his truck. The juvenile then shook her head (no) again. The W/M subject then asked "Are you sure?" to which the juvenile shook her head (yes). The W/M subject then stated "That's three no's in one sentence, we'll have to do something about that". at which point the juvenile reached for her cell phone from her pocket and pretended to make a phone call, while running to catch up to her friends who were walking further ahead. This incident occurred near the Brittany Bay subdivision of the Silver Lakes community.

Although the only information available at the present time is limited, we are asking for assistance from the media in broadcasting this information for purposes of increased awareness and public safety, in hopes of identifying the listed subject. If any other juvenile has experienced a similar encounter with someone fitting the description of the listed subject / vehicle, we ask that they contact the PPPD and provide us with that information.

Captain Xiques will be available for sound bites between 2:30-3:00 pm at Police Headquarters if requested.
