At this time, we can confirm that the listed residence where Mr. Carl Patrick’s body was located is also believed to be the same location where this incident occurred. It is believed that Ms. Teniko Thompson was the live-in girlfriend of Mr. Patrick. As a result of her recent statements to the media, Detectives from the Pembroke Pines Police Department would like the opportunity to speak with her regarding this incident, and will continue to reach out to her and her attorney.

We are asking for assistance from anyone who may have information or details regarding this case that may assist our investigation, to please contact the Pembroke Pines Police Department or Crime Stoppers.

It should also be noted that any statements made by representatives of other entities relating to this criminal investigation, other than from the Pembroke Pines Police PIO, should be considered unofficial.

The continued investigation has revealed that the deceased person, found inside of the listed residence, is Mr. Carl Ronald Patrick D.O.B. 5-27-61. Mr. Patrick was a Police Officer with the City of Miami Police Department. The cause of death has been determined to be homicide, as a result of a gunshot wound. Detectives will continue their investigation at the listed residence throughout the day and evening.

This remains an active criminal investigation. As such, we will not be releasing any additional information at this time.

On today's date at 2:47 PM, Pembroke Pines police officers responded to the above address, to conduct a welfare check. Upon continued investigation, officers entered the residence and found a deceased person. At this time the body has not been positively identified, and therefore, next of kin has not been notified.

This is an active criminal investigation, and no additional information will be released at this time.
