On the above date at approximately 5:30 pm, investigators from the Pembroke Pines Police Department secured a signed arrest warrant for Ms. Tiniko Braddy Thompson, in the homicide of City of Miami Police Officer Carl Ronald Patrick. Ms. Thompson was taken into police custody at approximately 7:00 pm. This case remains an active criminal investigation. As such, the information that can be provided at the present time is limited.

There will be a press conference scheduled for 8:30 pm tonight, at the PPPD Headquarters.

The continued investigation has revealed that the deceased person, found inside of the listed residence, is Mr. Carl Ronald Patrick D.O.B. 5-27-61. Mr. Patrick was a Police Officer with the City of Miami Police Department. The cause of death has been determined to be homicide, as a result of a gunshot wound. Detectives will continue their investigation at the listed residence throughout the day and evening.

This remains an active criminal investigation. As such, we will not be releasing any additional information at this time.

On today's date at 2:47 PM, Pembroke Pines police officers responded to the above address, to conduct a welfare check. Upon continued investigation, officers entered the residence and found a deceased person. At this time the body has not been positively identified, and therefore, next of kin has not been notified.

This is an active criminal investigation, and no additional information will be released at this time.
