RESCISSION OF PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE

Issued for:

City of Pembroke Pines Water Utility Customers West of I-75

The September 4, 2014, “Precautionary Boil Water Notice” is hereby rescinded. The satisfactory completion of a bacteriological survey shows that the water is safe to drink.

Due to a water line break early this morning, a loss of water to the following area may have been experienced:

I-75 West to US 27

The repair has been completed.

As a precaution, we are recommending that all water used for drinking, cooking, making ice, washing dishes, or brushing teeth be boiled. A rolling boil of at least one minute prior to consuming is sufficient. As an alternative, BOTTLED WATER MAY BE USED. The water is safe for non-consumptive uses. This "Precautionary Boil Water Notice" will remain in effect until a bacterio-logical survey shows that the water is safe to drink, at which point the boil water notice will be rescinded. This testing normally takes 2-3 days to complete.
