DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Missing Person: Pablo ALVAREZ; W/M/5-11-99; 6'3"/170lbs/Brown eyes/ Black hair; wearing grey jeans. Tattoo of "familia" in his lower right forearm; Tattoo of "Ana Maria with a picture of a rose" on his upper right forearm.

The Pembroke Pines Police Department is seeking the media and public's assistance in locating Pablo Alvarez. Pablo, who is 15 years old, was last seen leaving his residence on 12/18/14 at approximately 2:30PM. He advised his parents that he would be back by midnight, but did not make it home.

He suffers from depression and has recently attempted suicide. He is under medication but has not taken it in the past couple of days.

The investigation has revealed that Pablo may have been in the area of Kendall Dr. and 112th Ave last night.
