INCIDENT SUMMARY:

**** UPDATE: December 18, 2015, 12:30 pm ****

The Broward County Medical Examiner's Office notified the Pembroke Pines Police Department that at 3:45 am today Mr. Garcia succumbed to injuries sustained during the crash. The Traffic Homicide Unit will continue this investigation.

At 6:34 pm on Sunday, December 6, 2015, units from the Pembroke Pines Police and Fire Departments responded to the intersection of Pines Blvd and NW 103 Avenue for a crash involving a motorcycle.

Preliminary investigation revealed that John Paul Garcia was riding his white 2015 Harley Davidson motorcycle westbound in the center lane of Pines Blvd. As the motorcycle approached 103 Avenue, it changed lanes to the left to pass traffic; however, it went too far to the left and struck the median on the west side of the intersection. Mr. Garcia was thrown onto the roadway where he sustained serious injuries. Fire-Rescue transported him to Memorial Regional Hospital in critical condition.

This is an on-going investigation and no charges have been filed at this time.
