INCIDENT SUMMARY:

Pembroke Pines Police officers responded to suspicious incident located at the above listed location. Investigation revealed a customer entered the drive through lane to make a cash deposit. The customer transferred the cylinder from the drive through to the bank.

When the bank employee processed the transaction he suffered an allergic reaction that warranted a “911” call. Pembroke Pines Police, Pembroke Pines Fire Rescue, and Hollywood Fire Haz-Mat Crew #31 responded. As a result, the bank closed for business to allow members of both fire departments to analyze the cash deposit, plastic cylinder, and the building itself.

At approximately 1728 hours, members of the fire departments confirmed the substance was not hazardous or volatile. The fire departments also confirmed the building was safe to re-enter, and there was no hazardous threat to the public.

The bank employee was transported to Memorial Pembroke Hospital where he was treated and released

The customer who conducted the drive through transaction cooperated fully with the investigation. It was determined no criminal activity was associated with this incident.
