DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

In collaboration with the United Way of Broward County Commission on Substance Abuse (UWBCCSA), the Pembroke Pines Police Department will begin conducting underage alcohol compliance check operations and high visibility enforcement operations. These operations will target the illegal sale of alcohol to underage persons and the consumption and possession of alcohol by underage persons. This program began on March 17th, 2016 and will run through May 31st, 2016.

Alcohol vendors who are identified during the compliance check operations, that facilitate the illegal sale of alcohol to underage persons, will be offered the opportunity to attend an educational alcohol diversion program through the Sensible Education for Responsible Vendors & Employees (S.E.R.V.E.) Program, Inc.
