INCIDENT SUMMARY:

At 4:58 pm on Tuesday, March 22, 2016, units from the Pembroke Pines Police and Fire Departments responded to the 1800 block of NW 196 Avenue for a crash involving a vehicle versus tree.

Preliminary investigation revealed that Daniel Anthony McGill was driving his silver 2016 Ford Pickup Truck southbound on NW 196 Avenue from Sheridan Street. According to witnesses, the truck swerved onto the east swale in the 2300 block, returned to the roadway and then drove onto the west swale in the 1800 block, where it stuck trees and overturned. Pembroke Pines Fire-Rescue extricated Mr. McGill from his vehicle and transported him to Memorial Regional Hospital for treatment, where he was pronounced deceased at 5:45 pm.

This is an on-going investigation and no charges have been filed at this time.
