At approximately 07:02AM on 08-03-2016, a silver Toyota Corolla driven by Ana G. Hasset was traveling eastbound on the 9000 block of Johnson Street when it collided with a pedestrian. The pedestrian received serious injuries and was transported to Memorial Regional Hospital where he is listed in critical condition. The driver was uninjured.

The identity of the pedestrian is currently unknown, but he is described as a W/M (possibly hispanic), 5'6" in height, 230 lbs, in his mid-60s, with balding grey hair. At the time of the accident he was wearing khaki shorts and a light color tank top.

This remains an active investigation and we will update via Twitter when the roadway reopens.
