

Contest Rules and Regulations

Rules

Residents within the City of Pembroke Pines may enter their properties or nominate another resident for award consideration in the Natalie Belomonte Great Yards contest.

The contest will consist of five components, each worth 20 points each. These areas will be added together to reach the final score for the property. All entries must attain a minimum score of 70 to be eligible for an award and the highest score per district will win the award. There will be one award for each district (*Contingent upon participation in every district). Judging will be performed by the Landscape Advisory Board and the Landscape Advisory Board or any other City employee may visit, enter, view, and photograph or record the property for purposes of this contest. All decision(s) of the Landscape Advisory Board and the City shall be final. Awards will be presented at a City Commission meeting by the Mayor and City Commission in the month of May, in the spirit of Mother's Day and to honor Natalie Belmonte on her birthday month. Deadline for all submittals is April 14, 2016. Applications and/ or photos received after the deadline will not be considered.

Scoring Components

The five scoring components for each property are:

- **Butterfly component:** This area judges the preservation of all stages of a butterfly's life. It should supply food and shelter with the proper selection of plants which should include: host plants, caterpillar food plants, butterfly nectar plants and an area that provides about half a day's worth of sunlight. (sage, lavender, milkweed, goldenrod, firebush, penta... are some suggested plants).
- **Design and function:** This area judges the overall design, use of texture, compatibility of materials, continuity, balance, and the overall function of the landscape in correlation to the use of the property.
- **Maintenance:** The focus on this section will be the overall view of the property's landscape maintenance. The judges will be looking to see that the turf areas are mowed. They will also see that the planter beds are kept weed free, edged, and that mulching and fertilization is kept up.
- **Florida Friendly Value:** This section judges the selection and use of plants that have similar water demands. Mulching techniques will also be observed, checking to see if the mulch is deep enough to retain moisture in the soils. <http://fyn.ifas.ufl.edu/>
- **Use of Hardscapes:** This section judges the use of non-living additions to finish a landscape, such as fountains, ponds, statues, boulders, decks, mulch, stones, etc. The judging will be determined by implementation of these items into the landscape and how they fit into the overall property.



Contest Rules and Regulations

I hereby acknowledge and understand that by submitting any entry to the City of Pembroke Pines ("City") in response to the "Natalie Belmonte Great Yards Award" contest that I have the authority to transfer any rights, ownership, interest, and license in each submission, including photographic negatives and positives, to the City of Pembroke Pines, and hereby transfers all such rights, ownership, interest, and licenses in each submission to the City. Furthermore, the contestant agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the City, its officers, agents, employees and contractors, and the members of the Landscape Advisory Board, from and against any and all loss, damage, claim, demand, liability, or expense, including negligence, investigation costs and reasonable attorney's fees and costs, by reason of any damage or injury to person or property which may be claimed to have arisen or in connection with the "Natalie Belmonte Great Yards Award" contest, including, but not limited to, the submission of any entry, use any photograph or video either submitted or taken by the Landscape Advisory Board or other City employee, and the subsequent judging, including but not limited to entry upon the contestant's property. This obligation shall survive the termination of the "Natalie Belmonte Great Yards Award" contest and nothing in this release shall be interpreted as a waiver of the City's sovereign immunity as set forth in Section 768.28, Florida Statutes.
