CITY MANAGER'S REPORT

Jonathan Bonilla reminded parents that the enrollment lottery will end on Friday, March 10, 2023. He reported on fundraising efforts. The dress down days have raised \$22,000 for the year and corporate partners has brought in \$43,000 this year. The Florida pre-paid scholarship lottery raised \$17,000 with over 500 tickets sold.

He reminded parents about the upcoming dress down day. He reported that 160 tickets for the Miami Heat game were purchased.

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Principal Castellano spoke about the recent Raising Positive Children forum and thanked those that attended and who gave feedback. He reported on middle school sports.

He introduced Giselle Rodriguez, Office of Innovative Learning, who presented the Instructional Continuity Plan update, including reporting on prior use of grants and plans for the future use of this plan.

Mr. Chance presented an update of accreditation and stated that the City Manager would be leading the final review of data to be presented to the accreditation board.
