



Do you need help paying your energy bill?

EMERGENCY HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (EHEAP) can help!

- ✓ Are you age 60 or over and do you reside in Broward County?
- ✓ Have you received a “Past Due”, “Final” or “Disconnection” notice?
- ✓ Are you a United States citizen or a resident alien who is eligible for Public Assistance and Federal Benefits?
- ✓ Do you have documented Social Security Numbers and current photo ID’s (within 1 year of expiry) for all members of the household?
- ✓ Is your total Household Gross Income 150% of the Federal Poverty level or less, as documented by Social Security statements, pay stubs, etc.?
- ✓ Are you a homeowner, renter, or living in Section 8 Housing?
