Re: Fire Prevention Fees

Section 2 of the Annual Fire Inspections, Life Safety Plan Review and Apparatus; Fee Schedule adopted by Ordinance No. 1877, states that **"On October 1st of each year, the fees referred to above shall be increased, in accordance with the Consumer Price Index for Urban Consumers in the United States, published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics for the twelve (12) months ending April of each year, without City Commission approval, unless otherwise instructed by the City Commission."**

Effective October 1st, 2022, the fee schedule should be increased by 8.26%, as shown in the attached publication from the Bureau of Labor Statistics. If you concur with this, please indicate it in the space provided below.






