The opening ceremony at 6 pm will feature performances, check presentations and recognition of survivors and caregivers with a Medaling Ceremony.

7:00 PM - First Lap

The First Lap is scheduled for 7 pm. Everyone who has ever fought or knows someone who fought cancer is invited to walk the track at this time and cheer for survivors in attendance.

8:00 PM - Torches of Hope

At 8 pm the Torches of Hope, in remembrance of those who lost their battle with cancer, will be lit.

9:00 PM - Luminaria Ceremony

At 9 pm the Luminaria Ceremony will take place, lining the entire track with lit bags honoring and remembering those who have battled cancer.


